## RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH THE HOURS FOR SELLING OF BEER IN MARSHALL COUNTY, TENNESSEE

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-5-201, authorized County Legislative Bodies to extend the hours for sale of beer within their jurisdiction: and

WHEREAS, the City of Lewisburg has passed liquor by the drink in a referendum, the hours for sale of beer in the entire county are automatically altered to so that the hours for beer sales are the same as the hours established in T.C.A. 57-4-203(d) for the sale of liquor by the drink.

WHEREAS, the Marshall County Commission extended the hours for the sale of beer in Resolution 02-03-04 to be that no beer or like beverage shall be sold or given away between the hours of three o'clock a.m. (3:00 a.m.) and six o'clock a.m. (6:00 a.m.) on weekdays, or between the hours of three o'clock (3:00 a.m.) and twelve o'clock noon (12:00) on Sundays.

WHEREAS, it is the will of many of the establishment owners of the county that the County Legislative body extend the hours for the sale of beer on Sunday.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the County Legislative Body of Marshall County hereby extend the hours on Sunday, as follows:

No beer or like beverage shall be sold in properly licensed establishments from between the hours of three o'clock (3:00 a.m.) and ten o'clock a.m. (10:00) on Sundays.

This resolution shall be effective upon its passage and approval.
